Along with the completion of this form, you will be required to provide: a 250 to 500 word essay on the goals of the CCMMS www.ccmms.ca - i.e. to portray or preserve the stories / history of the Chinese Canadian Veterans. Videos, slides, photos, graphic novels or other innovative technologies are acceptable.

Objective:

To establish a Scholarship Program for veterans and museum members' families to assist them in pursuing post-secondary education in a field of their choice/endeavour. The scholarship is open to students attending: College, University, Trade Institutions, Fine Arts - including Video, Film, dance and Music Schools.

Qualification:

Applicants should be a family member of a Canadian veteran, a member of the Chinese Canadian Military Museum Society in good standing AND/OR students who support and have made contributions to CCMMS goals as outlined on our web site www.ccmms.ca. The definition of a family member includes extended family (e.g. sons, daughters, nephews, nieces, grandchildren etc.)

Selection Criteria:

1. The applicant is required to send a letter of no more than 500 words stating his/her affiliation with the Chinese Canadian Military Museum Society and the reasons why he/she should be selected to receive this scholarship. Other acceptable application medium include: video; slideshow, graphic novel, photos etc.
2. Completed Scholarship Application Form
3. Copy of last school years' transcripts

Participation with museum and community activities such as volunteering at events, writing essays to promote the CCMMS, preserving the stories of sacrifices of the Chinese Canadian WWI and WWII veterans and the Chinese Canadian community would be given favourable consideration.

Amount of Scholarship:

The scholarship is for two successful applicants per year in the amount of \$500.00 each.

Timing:

An applicant can apply any time during the year. Applications will be reviewed and awarded in August of each year with the successful candidates announced in our Fall Newsletters. Unfortunately our annual Fall Gala Dinner where we present the successful applicant with a certificate might be cancelled this year.

Selection Committee:

A panel of three persons will be appointed to sit on the selection board to review all the applications and deliberate the selection by Sept 6, 2024.

Rights and Permissions:

CCMMS has permission to post the successful applicants submission and their photo on the CCMMS web site, and to use in any other brochures or media that promotes the CCMMS in perpetuity.

Pay It Forward:

The successful applicants agree to sign the “Pay It Forward” agreement below.
